Year 9 GCSE Options Process

As you are aware, your child will be starting their Key Stage 4 GCSE courses in September 2019. We will be beginning the options process with your child this week. Unlike previous years, there will be no subjects blocked against each other and so students will have a free choice of six subjects in order of preference. These will then be reduced to four final choices based on the feasibility of groupings. It is hoped that this will enable students to study the subjects they genuinely want to, rather than from a limited combination of option blocks.

There are a number of important events relating to the option's process which are designed to give yourself and your child as much information, support and guidance in making the most appropriate choices for their future. The dates and events are as follows:
