

Montserrat Caballé

Montserrat Caballé was a soprano opera singer who had an international career spanning over half a century. She won a new generation of fans after singing Barcelona with the lead singer of Queen, Freddie Mercury (the reason I know of her). Caballé was born into a working class in Barcelona and her musical talents became apparent to her family from early ages. The singer achieved her international acclaim in 1965 after she stepped in for another singer in the notoriously difficult role of Lucrezia Borgia in Donizetti's opera in New York. This debut went down in history as one of the greatest overnight successes and she went on to tour the world, starring in 90 opera roles and giving almost 4,000 performances in her career.
