Home based learning

Home based learning is a vital part of every child's academic success; not only does it develop their independence but it also supports their revision and recall skills, helping students to embed knowledge, skills and understanding. At The Ripley Academy, students are set regular home based tasks by their teachers using an online platform – satchel:one.

The way that students can access our online homework platform has been simplified by removing the need to remember numerous log ins and passwords. Parents/carers will still require a separate user name and password as before.

When students access Show My Homework the platform is now called 'satchel:one' and the web address is www.satchelone.com/login. This will bring up the screen shown below. Students select the 'student' box underneath where it says forgot password and then click on 'Sign in with Office 365'. Students are then required to log into their school account using their 7-digit user ID which they use to access computers in school. This ID number and their password links their account so students will be instantly recognised whenever they are logged in.

Should a student be absent from school then the class teacher will attach their daily lessons to this system so your child can complete the work at home to prevent them from missing important content.

I'd also like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support with ensuring your child has returned to school wearing their uniform with great pride and exceeding our already high expectations.
