At The Ripley Academy, we believe that Personal Development is a vital part of your child's education and growth. Our carefully planned curriculum is designed to support our students in developing the knowledge, skills, and understanding they need to lead confident, healthy, and responsible lives, both now and in the future.

This year, your child will take part in a range of lessons and activities through our Personal Development curriculum, covering the following key areas:

- Managing Change Students will be able to recognise how transitions in their lives can have an impact on them. Students will begin to think about their future and what career they would like.
- **Puberty and Body Development** Students will start to learn and understand what puberty is and what this can look and feel like. Students will be able to name parts of the reproductive system.
- **Friends, Respect & Relationships** Students will know what "consent" means and how important this is. They will be able to describe what makes a good friend and explain why some relationships are not positive.
- **Staying Safe Online and Offline** Students will learn about the dangers of society both on and offline. They will know the dangers of online gaming, drugs and alcohol.
- **Celebrating Differences** Students will understand how they can help break down stereotypes and understand what the equality act is.
- Politics & Parliament Students will understand why parliament exists and why it is important.
